

ADMISSION

Admission is based on the rules on procedures for exercising the right to institutional care.

Admission procedure:

- Obtaining information from the social services of the institution,
- Applying for admission or transfer to institutional care,
- An application signed by the applicant or guardian,
- A declaration of consent from the prospective resident to be placed in an institution,
- A psychiatrist's opinion,
- An opinion of a personal physician,
- A statement from the payer of the service.

ABOUT US

Dom Lukavci is a public special care institution. It provides institutional care for adults with long-term mental health problems and mental and/or physical disabilities. Dom Lukavci operates from its site at Lukavci 9. Moreover, there are few dislocated residential units outside the main site, where life takes place in small residential groups.



In Dom Lukavci, there are 321 residents, 191 of whom live at the headquarters in three interconnected buildings. In 2024, there will be a new rehabilitation centre for 15 residents whose court order has expired.

MISSION AND VISION OF THE INSTITUTION

We aim to make the residents' lives as close as possible to everyday life. Living arrangements give them influence and decision-making power over their own lives. We offer them support and aim for independent activities in the institution and the outpatient units. We also empower residents to engage in various activities in the community and help them return to their home environment.

WHAT DO WE OFFER?



Basic care such as accommodation, organisation of meals, and care.



Social care as a professionally managed activity; designed to provide social prevention, therapy, and guidance to users.



Care - assisting the user with personal hygiene, getting up, dressing, moving, walking, communication, and orientation.



Specialist outpatient nursing activity, which involves the independent, interdependent, and collaborative treatment and participation of the individual in the provision of nursing care; the specific area of nursing care provided in the institution is psychiatric nursing.



Occupational therapy.



Physiotherapy.

Services of a general practitioner, a psychiatrist, and a dentist provided by the Ljutomer Health Centre.

SERVICES IN DISLOCATED RESIDENTIAL UNITS

They provide a basic standard of living in single or double rooms, where life is lived in small household communities. The accommodation units are designed for:

- People with dementia,
- People with chronic mental health problems,
- People with intellectual disabilities and associated mental health problems,
- People with multiple disabilities who are accommodated on the basis of a court order (Verzej Residential Unit)
